

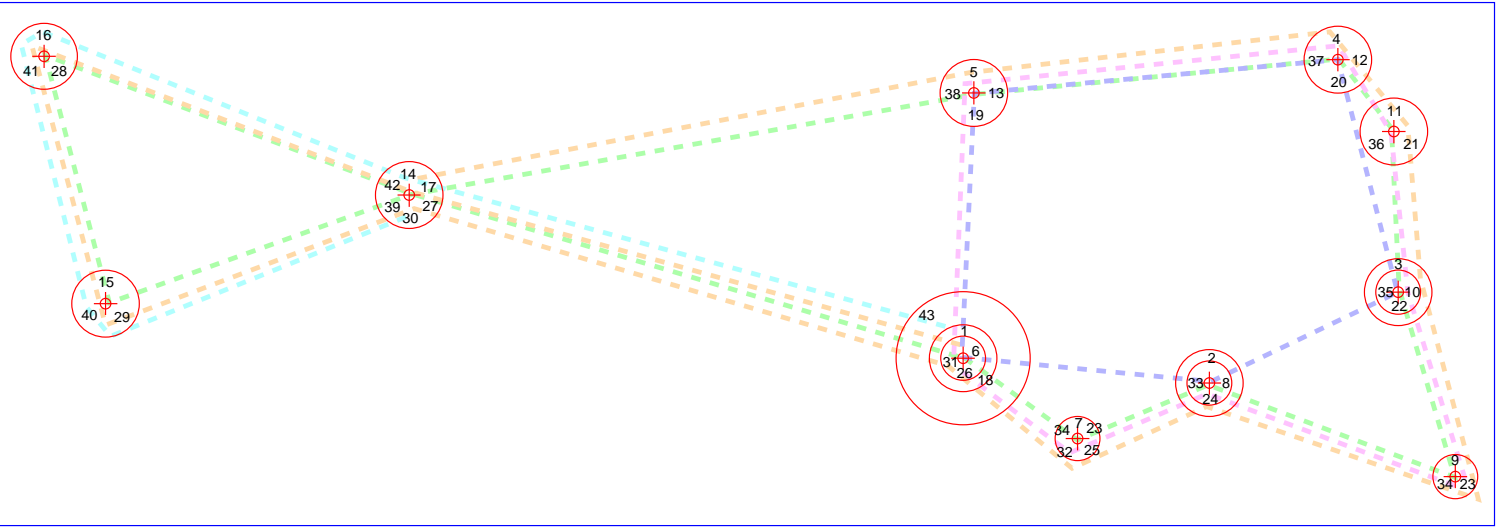

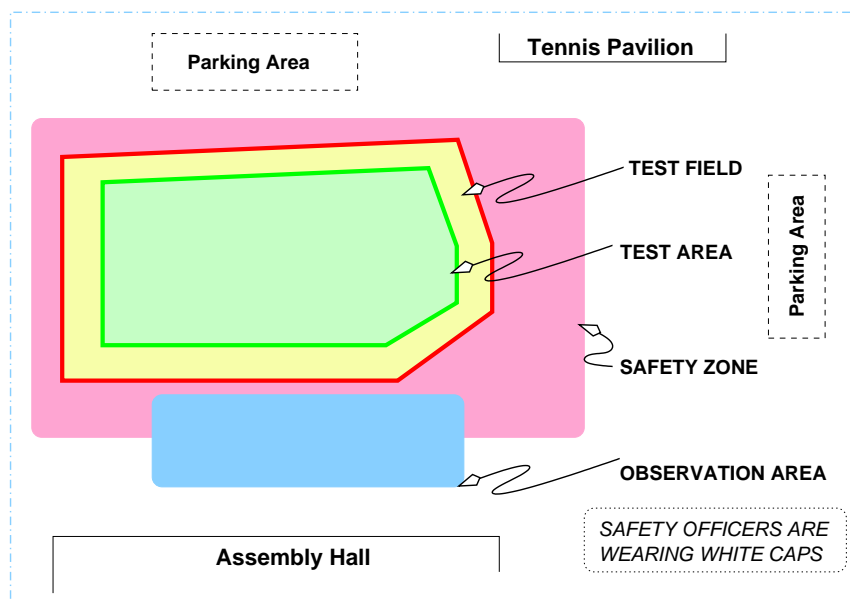

Digital (computer controlled) systems can fail in dramatic and unexpected ways. The value of a single bit (1 or 0), might determine whether a vehicle turns left or right, slows down or speed up, or perform an entirely unanticipated maneuver. Safety of persons (first) and property (second) is the highest concern

Observer Safety Rules

1. If you see or anticipate *any* potentially unsafe conditions, notify the Safety Officer *immediately*. The Safety Officer **may** suspend a test-in-progress until your concerns are resolved.
2. Help observe these rules by advising others who may be unaware of or infringing on them.
3. The boundaries of the *Test Field* are marked by traffic barriers, orange cones, and ropes.
4. Within the Test Field's boundaries is an unmarked, three-meter (10 feet) *Vehicle Safety Zone*. If the test vehicle strays into this zone, the Test Driver or Safety Officer **may** abort the test.
5. Outside the Test Field is an *Observer Safety Zone*. The Safety Official **shall** hold the start of a test until this area is clear. If, during testing, persons or vehicles enter this zone, the Test Driver **shall** abort the test.
6. Observers must to stay within *Observation Area* on the stairs, terrace, and driveway between Assembly Hall and the Test Field.



All participants and observers must be vigilant to maintain safe conditions. If you have any questions or concerns at any time, please bring them to the attention of a Safety Official (wearing a white cap) immediately.
