June 28, 2006

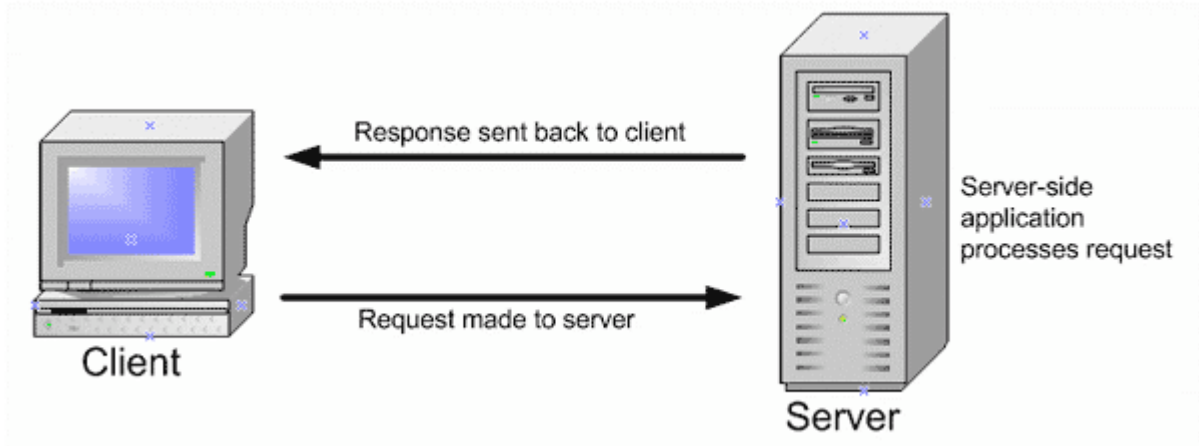
Today the first question was solved. But it is not stable. It is tested.
